Getting Started

- 1. Download the Freegal Music App for free from the iTunes App Store or Google Play Store.
- 2. Open the Freegal Music App.
- 3. Enter your zip code or type in "Miami" and select Go.
- 4. Select Miami-Dade Public Library System.
- 5. Enter your library card number and 4-digit PIN and select Login.

Using the Freegal Music App

- 1. Select **Search** (magnifying glass) to search for specific Artists, Songs or Albums.
- 2. Select **Browse** to browse Top Artists, Top Songs and Top Genres.
- 3. Select Play (blue triangle) located to the left of the track name to listen to a random 30-second sample.
- 4. Select Download (downward pointing arrow) located to the right of the track name to download a song.
 - Once you select Download, the song will count toward your weekly limit of 3 songs.
- 5. Select My Music to listen to downloaded songs.

Songs downloaded in the Freegal Music App cannot be transferred to the music library on your device. The songs must first be downloaded on a computer and then transferred to your device. Songs first downloaded in the Freegal Music App will be available to download onto your computer for 2 weeks.

- 1. Go to the Freegal catalog.
- 2. Click Login.
- 3. Enter your library card number and PIN and click Log In.
- 4. Click Downloads from the My Downloads section on the left side of the window.
- 5. Click **Download** to download the song to your computer.
